MEDAL FROM THE BRITISH QUEEN FOR WECF DELEGATE

Andy Dalton, one of the delegates to the 12th WECF Triennial Meeting, is Secretary of Morley Community Church and a regular contributor to *Our Congregational World*.

He recently received a letter from the British monarch, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth. She informed him that he was to receive the **British Empire Medal (BEM)** in her Official Birthday Honours List. The prestigious medal is for services to church, community and youth. Andy is a founding member of Morley Community Church (EFCC UK) which began in 2000 and he has played a major role in its development over the last two decades. This includes the spearheading of youth and children's work, the organisation of 'Gap Year' workers from overseas, who serve the church/town for one year (promoting international links) and his contribution as a Christian to the wellbeing of the community.



Morley is a northern UK industrial town with a heritage in textiles and mining, with little evangelical witness. Andy has numerous other responsibilities including lay preaching and serving as secretary of the local branch of the Gideons. He has been a town councillor for twenty years and served as Mayor in 2013.
